



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77 Our everyday reality is the world we experience through our senses. It contains everything we can see, hear, smell, touch and feel. It is an explicit order and for us actually present as a direct surface order. Underneath there is a deeper, for humans only indirectly knowable or inaccessible order. A multidimensional sea of energy as an implicate order from which particles and spacetime can arise. This underlaying reality and the explicit order as we experience it on a daily basis are intrinsically interwoven, amounting to one non-local, nonanalysable breath breathing system, enfolding and unfolding at every moment into a complex, never fully knowable totality as a portrait of God.
